



PATIENT INFORMATION

PREPARATION FOR BREAST MRI EXAMINATION

- The examination should be performed:
 - Between the 7th and 14th day of the monthly cycle (the first day of bleeding is considered the first day of the cycle),
 - 3 months after the completion of hormone therapy,
 - 1 year after surgery and radiation therapy,
 - 6 months after vacuum assisted biopsy is performed.
- Three days before the scheduled examination, do not use deodorants/antiperspirants or lotions with iridescent elements, such as glitter, on the chest area.
- It is absolutely necessary to have up-to-date mammography results on the day of the examination (including images or CDs, *this does not apply to women with BRCA1 and BRCA2 mutations*) and breast ultrasound, as well as any information regarding past treatment and procedures (hospital discharge cards, histopathological examination results)
- On the day of the examination you should not eat any meals for about 2 hours before the examination
- On the day of the examination, you should have current serum creatinine level and GFR results (2-7 days before the examination).
