PATIENT INFORMATION**PREPARATION FOR ABDOMINAL ULTRASOUND EXAMINATION FOR A CHILD**

1. Neonates require no preparation
2. Children under 2 years of age – last feeding about 3 hours before the examination
3. Children of 2 - 8 years of age – last meal 5 hours before the examination.
4. Children over 8 years of age – approximately 6 hours fasting.

All children should be given something to drink about 30 minutes before the examination – still water being the preferred fluid. The examination is performed with a full bladder.
